



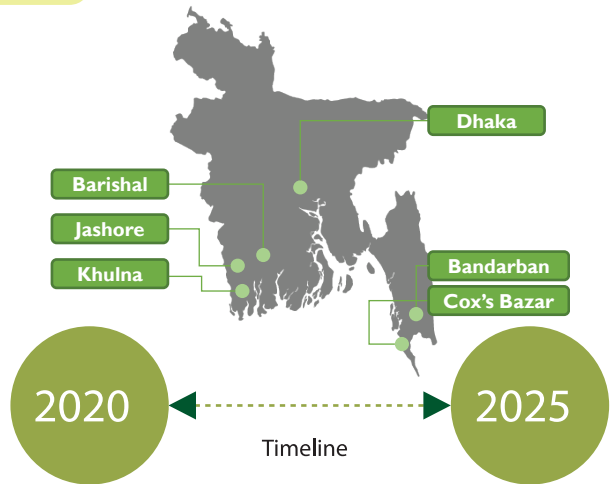
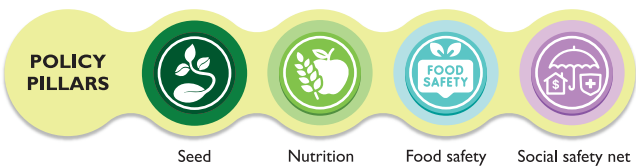

GOAL :

Strengthening the capacities of Bangladesh's key agricultural actors and institutions, improving the policy environment, and cultivating the policy-making decision processes that will enable inclusive and sustainable agriculture-led economic growth, strengthen the resilience among people and systems, and create a well-nourished population, especially women and children.

2. Strengthened communication, coordination and cooperation among institutions for more effective & accelerated food & nutrition policy implementation in Bangladesh.
3. Increased influence of Bangladeshi actors & communities in food & nutrition security policy & governance formulation & implementation.
4. Increased excellence & collaboration in participatory policy learning & knowledge sharing practices.

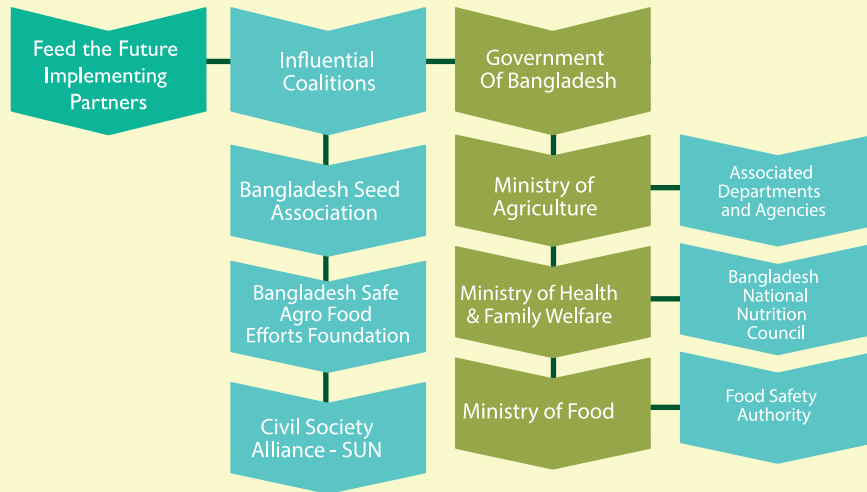
